The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order approving a settlement stipulation imposing a fine of \$750.00 plus costs and 33 hours of continuing education against Leslie Fernandez's license to practice architecture. Ms. Fernandez affirmed at renewal that she had completed the required hours and only provided 9 hours of continuing education during the audit period.
